Gathering Information:

- We will plan any construction needs and space planning of the layout or any functional concerns or desires.
- We will help you choose door styles, finishes, and wood species.
- We will discuss appliances that will work for you.
- We have a variety of counter top materials that will coordinate with your design and many different sink styles and materials to select from.
- Your decorative hardware can be chosen from many selections of styles and we will gladly help you decide.
- During the planning phase we will help you with your budget and guide you where you need to be.

Design Phase:

Before The Project Begins:

- Remove all items from cabinets, appliances, pantries, walls, counter tops and any furniture that may be in the way during the remodel phase. Please pack and store items away while the construction is being done.
- Be prepared for dust and cover any items that will not be stored or packed away during the construction phase.
- Set up a temporary kitchen area for cooking, washing and refrigeration. You will not have access to your kitchen sink and may have to use the bathroom sink or a laundry sink, if available. Consider using paper plates and plastic utensils and remember to recycle whenever you can!

The Installation Process:

- We want this phase to go smoothly and quickly; therefore, any cabinet and counter top tear outs, wall changes, plumbing or electrical issues must be addressed before the cabinets are delivered.
- We make sure your contractor is aware of any unforeseen issues that may occur so they can be handled before your new cabinetry is installed.
- There will be a timeline given for your project according to its size and complexity. Tile flooring and some engineered wood flooring may need to be installed before cabinets are installed.
- A typical schedule usually starts with tear out of cabinetry, counter tops, appliances, flooring, and soffits followed by any plumbing and electrical modifications, drywall repair, painting and flooring. Cabinetry installation begins and will take about 2 to 5 days depending on the size of the project. We will then template counter tops which may take up to 12 days for installation. During that time, appliances should be installed, electrical and plumbing can be hooked up. Trim out is the final step.

Fine Tuning Your Project:

- ❖ We will do a final walk through with you, notating any items that may need attention, to assure your project is complete.
- ❖ Proper care and maintenance brochure as well as manufacturer's warranty papers will be provided.
